- 70%+ average (level 6) for final Grade 11 results (excluding LO)
- South African Citizen
- Applicants must be under the age of 22 on 27 July 2018
- Study a 3year BSc, BA or BCom at UCT or UP in 2019
- Intention to complete a PGCE and teach in a South African high school
